- ◇ Wear a mask
- ◇ And please make sure:
  - You don't have more than 37.0℃
  - You don't have a cold
  - You don't feel very tired or have odor and taste problems
  - That no one living with you has any of the above symptoms
  - That you haven't been in any event with more than 50 people in the last 14 days
  - Or had any contact with people infected with Covid-19 in the last 14 days
- ◇ Lunch boxes will be given out after consultation, but please don't eat in the compounds.
